

Ford focuses on reducing CO₂ emissions



FACILITIES

Total CO₂ emissions at Ford's global facilities have dropped by 4.65 million metric tons, or 47 percent since 2000



CLIMATE CHANGE

Ford has plans to meet its own targets while also doing its part to help keep Earth's atmosphere within levels many say must be met to avoid the most serious effects on climate change



PRODUCTS AND TECHNOLOGIES

Vehicles such as C-MAX Hybrid and C-MAX Energi plug-in hybrid help Ford reduce emissions – already saving 20 billion grams of CO₂ from the atmosphere



CO₂ reduction

Ford has cut CO₂ emissions at its global facilities by 37 percent per vehicle between 2000 and 2012



Ford targets an additional reduction of 30 percent per vehicle between 2010 and 2025
