The Henry Ford Teacher Fellow Program is led by Paula Gangopadhyay, Director of Education at The Henry Ford, who possesses national-level museum education and school-reform leadership experience. Mary Wyatt, Associate Curator of Education, is the coordinator of the sessions and will act as the teacher liaison.

Commitment Required

- Three weeks at The Henry Ford: June 20-24, June 27-July 1 and July 11-15, 9am - 5pm.

Application Timeline

- Deadline for applications: May 31, 2011 (Post-marked. No late applications will be accepted)
- Selection notification: June 15, 2011
