OTHER ACCOMMODATIONS

GREENFIELD VILLAGE

AUGUST 10 - 12, 2012

The Henry Ford has open, dorm room style, bunk beds available for participants to the *World Tournament of Historic Base Ball*. These dorms are used for our over night museum programs as well as for participants at other events. The rooms are labeled 'GAME 1 – 4'.

Game 1 is for women, Game 2 is for men (southeast side) and
Game 3 & 4 is CO-ED (northwest side).

These accommodations are located in Lovett Hall – Greenfield Village and Henry Ford Museum administration building and offices. There is access to showers and locker rooms for men and women as well as simple vending machines. A sleeping bag or bed linens are encouraged as the beds have a cushion/mattress only.

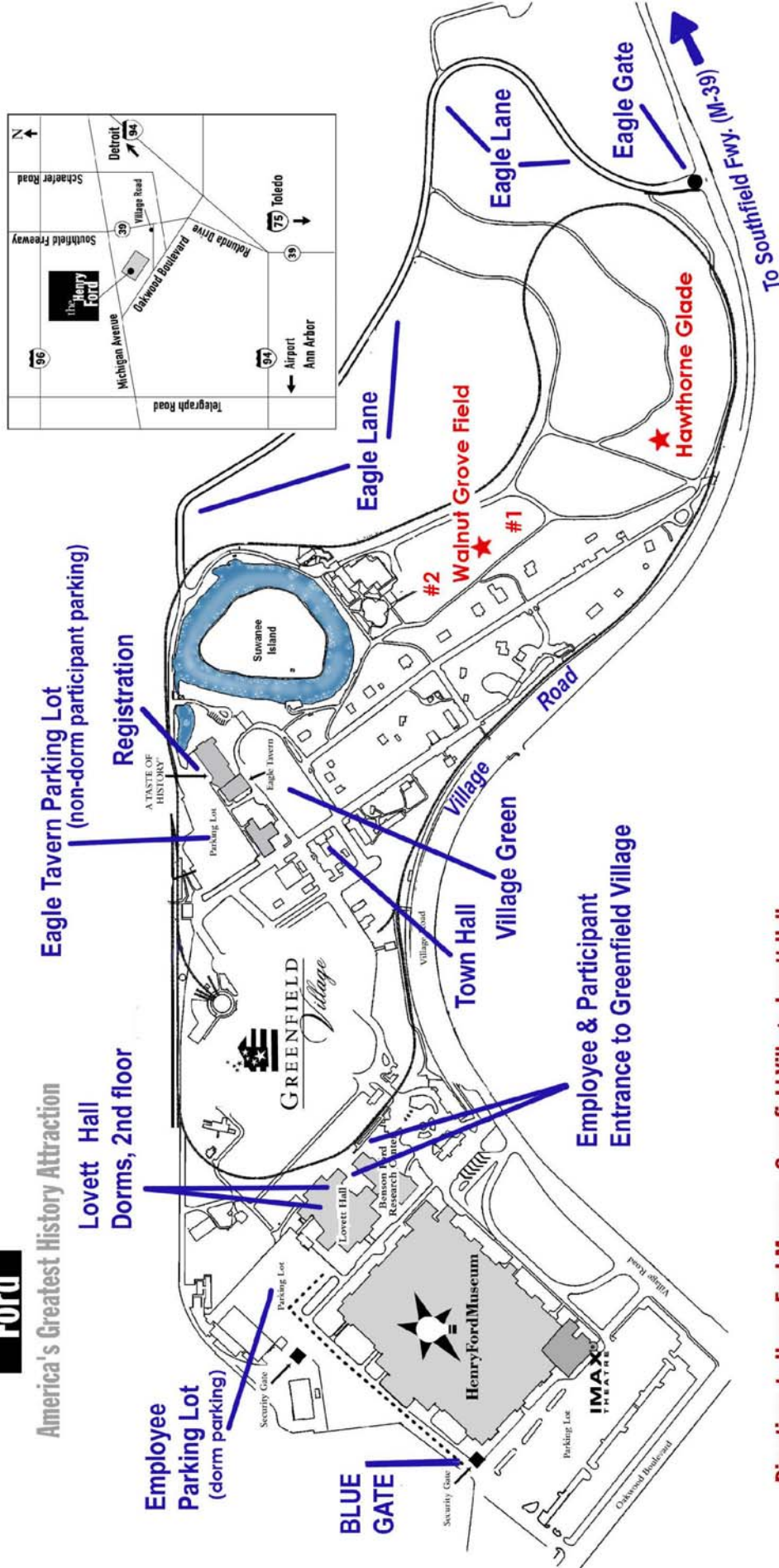
Participants staying in the dorms can either walk to the game fields in Greenfield Village via the employee entrance in Lovett Hall or drive around from Blue to Eagle Gate (or visa versa) from Lovett Hall Parking Lot to Eagle Tavern Parking lot. Please do not drive in Greenfield Village.

The accommodations are free to participants and their immediate families from Friday, August 12th – through Sunday night August 14th, 2011. Participants using the dorms should park in the EMPLOYEE LOT behind LOVETT HALL via the BLUE GATE. Participants can then enter Greenfield Village via the Employee/participant Entrance.

Participants using the dorms can simply show up and take a bed – checking in / registration for dorm use is not necessary.

Directions to Henry Ford Museum, Greenfield Village, Lovett Hall, IMAX® Theatre, and Benson Ford Research Center ■ (313) 982-6220

From I-94: Exit to northbound Oakwood Boulevard; go two miles.

From I-75: Exit to northbound Southfield Freeway (M-39); go eight miles. Exit right lane to northbound Oakwood Boulevard; go two miles.

From I-96: Exit Southfield (M-39) south, drive six miles.

Exit northbound on Oakwood Boulevard (exit #4), drive three miles.

Enter off of Oakwood Boulevard or Village Road.

For Eagle Tavern, A Taste of History, Village Pavilion, Martha Mary Chapel, enter via Eagle Lane gate on Village Road, follow Eagle Lane to parking lot.

For Lovett Hall and Benson Ford Research Center, proceed to rear of museum by entering through security gate off Oakwood, then follow the road behind the museum to stop sign. Continue straight ahead to parking lot, and follow the on this map.

For Henry Ford Museum, drop-off available in front of Clock Tower Entrance using circular drive, parking available by IMAX Theatre.
