Evening Admission

\$12-\$18 per person

Includes evening admission (starting at 6:30pm) with full event support staff including event planning, facilities, security and visitor service (Minimum admission of \$2,500).

Innovation Package

\$20-\$25 per person

Includes evening admission (starting at 6:30pm) with premium event support including VIP welcome address, Museum presenter staffed exhibits and tours, plus podium with microphone (Minimum admissions of \$3,000).

Areas included with Henry Ford Museum event:

Museum Plaza

The Plaza is the focal point of most Museum events. Surrounded by the highlights of our collection, an ideal setting for galas, wedding receptions and large events. Serves up to 500 banquet, 5,000 strolling.

Prechter Promenade

Our grand entrance. Use as a reception area for a lavish introduction to your evening, or as an elegant pre-function area. Serves up to 500 reception style.

Driving America Car Court

Michigan hottest new event space! Perfect for seated and strolling dinners, also pre-function receptions and afterglows. Serves 150 banquet, 500 strolling.

Flexible Exhibit Gallery Lobby

The popular area featuring our temporary exhibit is ideal for hosting cocktail receptions, afterglows or desserts. Exhibit may be an additional charge. Serves 400 strolling.

Pennsylvania Courtyard

A gracious, open-air court yard, suited to outdoor cocktail receptions or a ceremony of up to 400 guests. (Additional \$950 ceremony fee).

Douglas Auto Theater

Despite the name, this replica of a classic Drive-In Theater is *inside* the museum. A perfect location for showcasing a media presentation for up to 100 guests, technology fee may apply.

Henry Ford Museum

Museum Venues available independently:

Anderson Theater

\$950-\$2,400

Our historic theater features gold-gilded décor, an upper balcony, private restrooms and a spacious stage. Just the place for your presentation or wedding ceremony for up to 600 guests. Includes up to 4-hours for set-up, program and tear down. Facility Fee of \$950 with accompanying evening museum private event, or \$2,400 for daytime presentation. Please note, Anderson Theatre does not include Museum admission or offer a food and beverage reception area.

IMAX Theater

\$2,250-\$6,000

Michigan's largest IMAX screen and our million-dollar projector will give take your audiences to places they never imagined. Think BIG! Theater seats up to 427 guests for 2-D, and 392 guests for 3-D films. Private screenings \$2,250-\$6,000 per show, plus concessions (based on current schedule and film displacement).

IMAX Lobby serves up to 200 reception style, additional rental fee and minimum food expenditure will apply.

Unique event venues available within Greenfield Village:

Eagle Tavern

\$500

Host a one-of-a-kind event that immerses your guests in 19th century Michigan hospitality. Offer an authentic historical experience, or select a modern menu, and enjoy the warm candle-lit atmosphere. Perfect for a corporate event or an intimate wedding that will be talked about for years. Serves up to 180 banquet, 135 with dance floor. Available for evening events, starting after 6:30pm.

Taste of History

\$500

Panoramic windows, a spacious, shaded patio and a menu to satisfy your taste buds' desires. A modern and fun venue - quirky, but with all the conveniences. Serves up to 160 banquet, 125 with dance floor. Available for evening events, starting after 6:30pm.

Michigan Café

\$800

A light-hearted Michigan-themed décor imbues this space with a fun and casual atmosphere. Attached to Henry Ford Museum, perfect for a pre-Greenfield Village special event function, including Holiday Nights or Hallowe'en in Greenfield Village. Serves up to 130 banquet for evening events, starting at 6:30pm. Rental does not include admission.

Village Pavilion

\$1,000

Ideally located in the heart of the Village, overlooking the Village Green, the new Playscape and the Carousel, this 5,000-square-foot all-season venue is the perfect setting for a picnic. The Village Pavilion is completely enclosed and features six oversized retractable doors which open to its own brick-paved garden patio.

(All inclusive picnic packages include pavilion rental, picnic menu and village admission starting as low as \$39 per person.) Picnics for 150-900 or banquet buffets for up to 300 guests. Village admission required during public hours.

Martha Mary Chapel

\$950-\$2,000

With an elegant pipe organ, towering ceiling, candle-lit chandelier and a doorway that opens onto the Village Green, Martha Mary Chapel has the refined beauty of an 19th century New England church. A picturesque setting for the storybook ceremony of your dreams, seating up to 125 guests. Facility fee of \$2,000 or \$950 with catered event in *Greenfield Village*.

Walnut Grove

\$1,500

Our signature setting for large-scale tented picnics and events for 500-10,000 guests, Tent Package (through The Henry Ford) required at additional fee. Village admission required during public hours.

Greenfield Village Buyout

\$15,000 - \$50,000

One of America's great showplaces can be all yours. Exclusive evening (6:30pm-10:00pm) of *Greenfield Village* and its amenities for groups of 500 to 10,000. District buyouts of Main Street or Liberty Craftworks available for smaller groups of 1,000 guests or fewer.



Ford Rouge Factory Tour

The *Ford Rouge Factory Tour* is a five-part adventure where visitors see how cutting-edge environmental practices and industrial innovation mesh to create one of the world's most enlightened and forward-looking factories.

This visionary manufacturing facility is a one-of-a-kind setting for private or semi-private function incorporating a fully interactive experience into your event. All events include the five signature elements of America's greatest manufacturing experience:

- A three-screened film about the ideas that gave birth to the Rouge Plant and its unique role in American history.
- A 360-degree, multi-sensory presentation where visitors experience the full gamut of the factory's sights, sounds and sensations.
- An observation deck to view the highlights of the environmentally enlightened facility.
- An in-depth tour of the Final Assembly from an elevated walkway at the Dearborn Truck Plant.
- The Legacy Gallery, where guests see some of the Rouge's legendary vehicles.

Morning Event

Private breakfast with semi-private tour for up to 150 guests.

- Creative meeting space can be arranged for groups of 75 or fewer.
- Transportation not included.

Evening Event

Exclusive use of the *Ford Rouge Factory Tour* for private tours of up to 300 guests.

- Private events start at 5:30pm. Catered functions begin at/after 6:30pm.
- Facility fee, \$3,000-\$5,000 (varies by start time and guest count).
- Dinner service, capacity is 100 guests seated, 300 guests strolling.
- Transportation not included.
- Theater-style meeting space available.

All-Day Event

Exclusive private use of *Ford Rouge Factory Tour* for the day for up to 1,350 guests.

- Facility Fee, \$12,000.
- Facility rental from 9:00am to 5:00pm (can be extended for additional fee).
- Includes *Ford Rouge Factory Tour* buses departing from *Henry Ford Museum* or alternate single location (see sales rep for details).

Lovett Hall

Henry Ford built this glorious ballroom to house the dances he and his wife, Clara hosted. They lavished attention on the facility, and it shows; Burmese teak floor, crystal chandeliers and enormous paired fireplaces. Lovett Hall is arguably the most gracious and most elegant ballroom in the Midwest.

With a Lovett Hall event, the only limitation is your imagination. Even the terrazzo lobby is magnificent, with its adjoining library, garden and courtyard. It is, unquestionably, *the* setting for, a sparkling awards gala or a memorable wedding reception. Ballroom and Foyer

The elegance and glamour Lovett Hall ballroom can now be yours. From the moment your guests enter this remarkable 1930's gem, they'll find themselves surrounded by an air of unsurpassed refinement. Serves up to 350 guests for seated banquet (300 with dance floor).

Lovett Lobby

The epitome of 1930's chic; marble flooring and a 14-foot high ceiling with crown molding provides a magnificent setting for a cocktail reception or wedding ceremony. Serves 300 guests for reception, 270 guests for Wedding Ceremony (additional \$950 ceremony fee).

Ginger Meyer Garden

Lovett Hall's most picturesque garden is enhanced by intricate brickwork, a cultured limestone gazebo and statue of Ceres, the Roman goddess of agriculture. Ideal for wedding ceremonies and cocktail receptions. Serves up to 300 guests for reception, 270 guests for Wedding Ceremony (additional \$950 ceremony fee).

Original library of The Edison Institute, this charming space can be used for a variety of functions during your Lovett Hall event. Capacity varies according to set-up needs.

The Henry Ford is pleased to offer a lovely selection of exquisite wedding ceremony locations available with your onsite reception.

Ceremony Venue and Facilitation

\$950

Includes one-hour venue access for the ceremony and photographs, a one-hour rehearsal the week of the wedding (date and time confirmed sixty days in advance) and a guest service representative to assist at both the rehearsal and wedding ceremony.

Important Note: When reserving an outdoor location, The Henry Ford will also reserve an indoor alternative in case of inclement weather. The Henry Ford will "call" weather by 12-noon on the business day prior to the ceremony.
