### ALLEGHENY LOCOMOTIVE

#### Located in Railroads

One of the largest steam locomotives ever built, the 1941 Allegheny was designed for the Chesapeake & Ohio Railway.



### LINCOLN CHAIR

#### Located in With Liberty and Justice for All

The life of President Lincoln, who was assassinated in this chair at Ford's Theatre in 1865, represents the devotion and preservation of America's founding principles.



### QUADRICYCLE

#### Located in Driving America

This gas-powered vehicle produced by Henry Ford possessed a light and simple design, characteristics that would later pave the way for his most famous invention, the Model T.



### KENNEDY PRESIDENTIAL LIMOUSINE

#### Located in Presidential Vehicles

The 1963 assassination of President Kennedy in this limousine represented a pivotal moment in our nation's history as Americans were consumed by shock, a sense of loss and fear for the future.



### ROSA PARKS BUS

#### Located in With Liberty and Justice for All

On December 1, 1955, Rose Parks boarded this Montgomery city bus and inspired a new era in the quest for American freedom and equality.



### WIENERMOBILE

#### Located near the Wienermobile Café

One of the most identifiable icons of modern marketing. The Wienermobile is inspired by kitsch, a nostalgic example of promotional brilliance.



### DYMAXION HOUSE

#### Located in Your Place in Time

R. Buckminster Fuller's all-aluminum house was conceived as the home of the future in the 1920s for its affordability and environmentally conscious design.

This 1939 plane revolutionized global aviation while logging more than 12 million miles in nine and a half years!


