Michigan Café

Lighthearted Michigan-themed décor makes for friendly, casual dining experiences.

- Serves up to 130 banquet.
- Facility fee of \$800 for evening events.
- Does not include Museum admission.
- Food minimum expenditure applies.

IMAX® Theatre

Michigan's largest IMAX® screen and our million-dollar projector will take your audiences to places they never imagined. Think BIG!

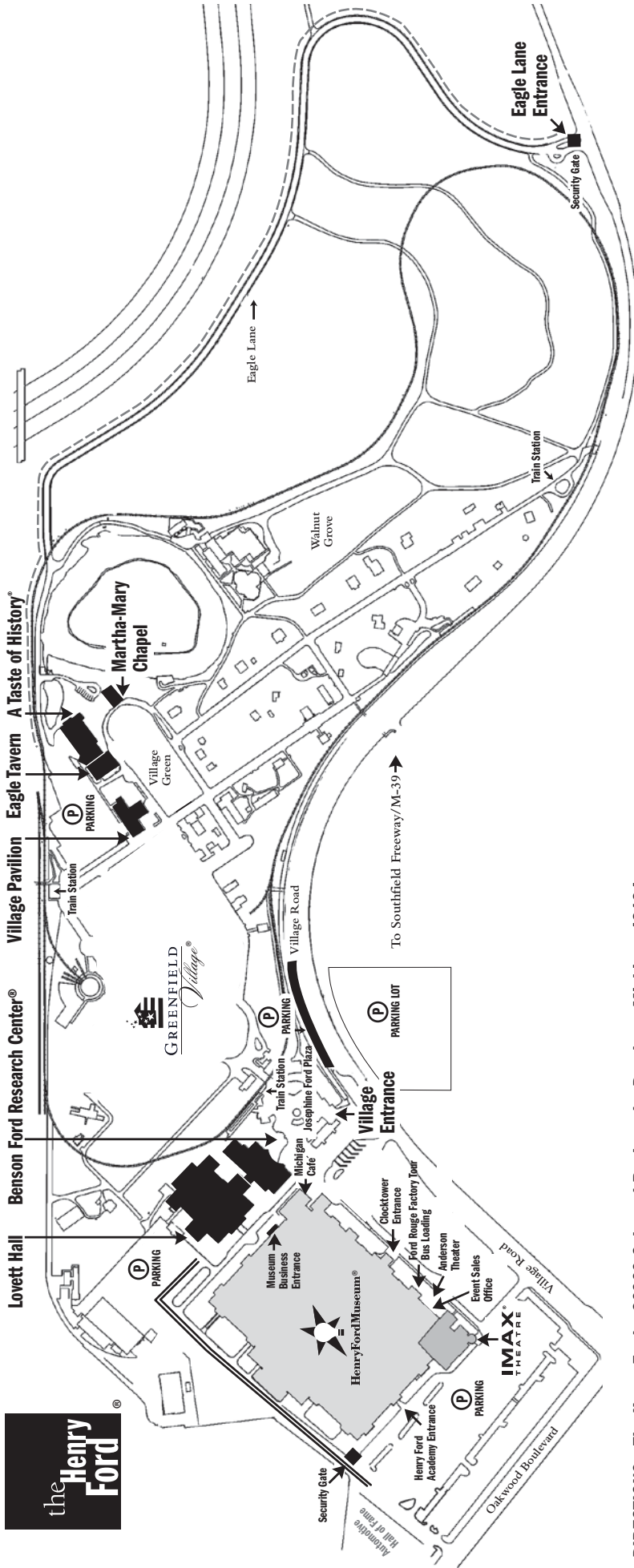

From I-94

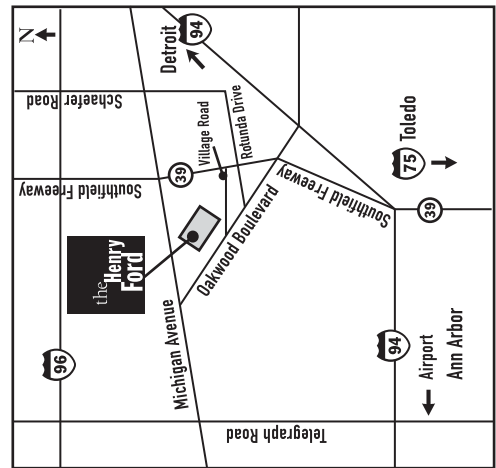
Exit to northbound Southfield Freeway (M-39). Drive 1.8 miles to Oakwood Boulevard (Exit 4). Left on Oakwood and drive 1.8 miles.

From I-75

Exit to northbound Southfield Freeway (M-39). Drive 4.1 miles to Oakwood Boulevard (Exit 4). Left on Oakwood and drive 1.8 miles.

From I-96

Exit southbound Southfield Freeway (M-39). Drive 4.5 miles to Michigan Avenue (Exit 6). Stay to left on service drive, then turn right at entrance on Village Road.

Benson Ford Research Center

Park in public parking; enter via Josephine Ford Plaza at Village Entrance. Parking on Village Road or in public parking lots across from Village Entrance.

Drop-off available in front of Clocktower Entrance using circular drive. Parking available by IMAX® Theatre.

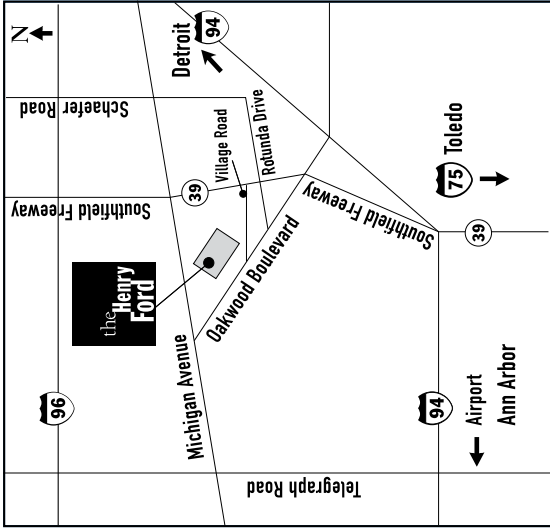
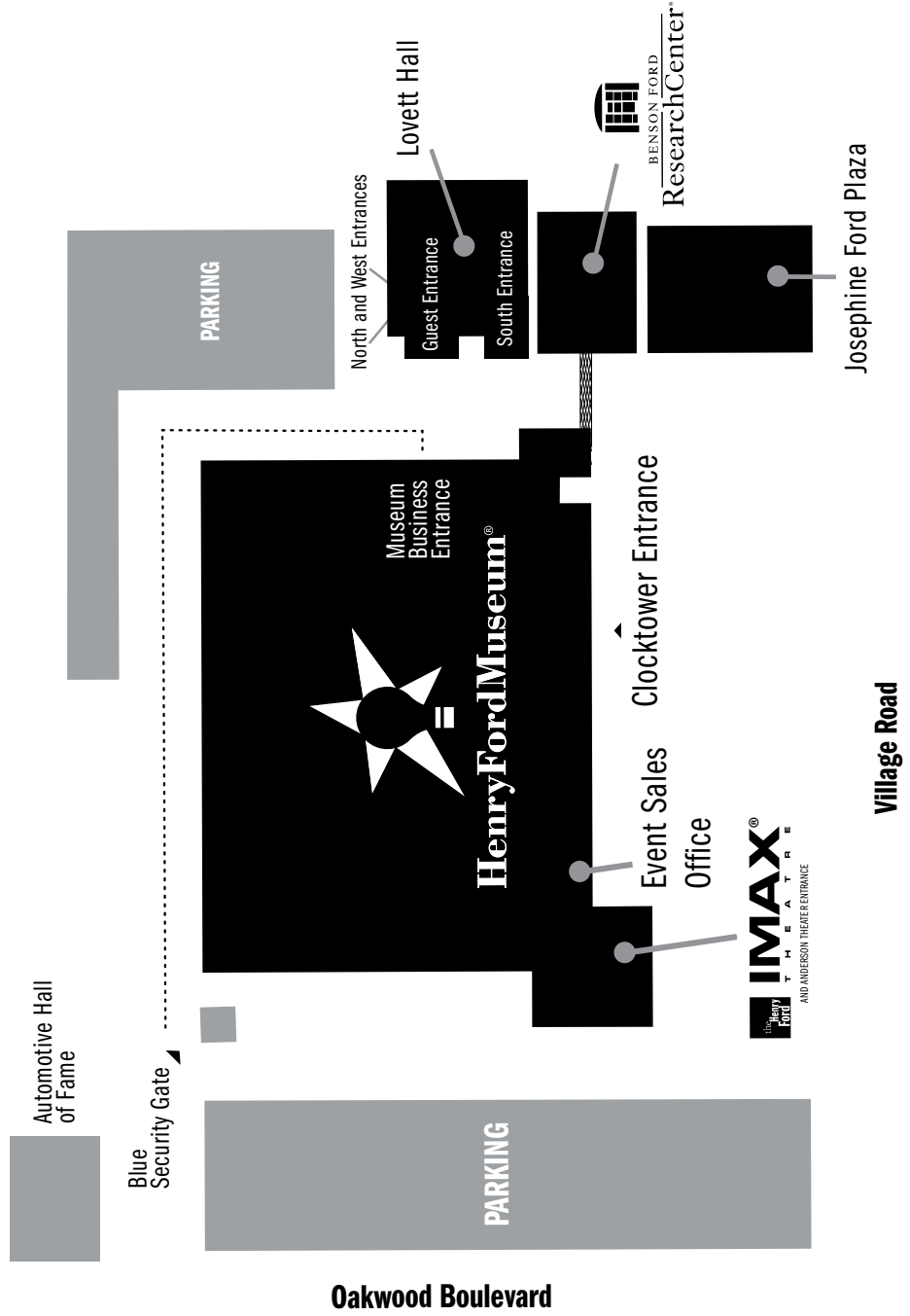

Event Deliveries

Please be sure you have a scheduled delivery time and pickup time, and know your group's name, date, event time and venue. Please note: Many venues are open to the public during the day, so delivery and setup times are usually in late afternoon; same-day pickup is always required. Most venues are large; vendors are responsible for their own cart or dolly with large rubber wheels. Electricity needs must be confirmed at least 3 weeks prior to event. Vendors are responsible for their own extension cords, turtles and/or safety covers.

All deliveries and setup services must enter through Blue Security Gate and check in with Museum Business Entrance Security upon arrival.

Museum Business Entrance for unloading only –no parking or blocking pedestrian crossing.

Henry Ford Museum: Deliveries to Museum Business Entrance only. No deliveries through Clocktower Entrance or IMAX® Entrance.

Lovett Hall: For deliveries to Museum Business Entrance or Lovett Hall South Entrance, please check with your sales representative. Vendors may enter South Entrance and service elevator only. No deliveries through Guest Entrance of Lovett Hall.

Eagle Tavern, A Taste of History®, Martha-Mary Chapel and Pavilion: Deliveries to Museum Business Entrance, unless otherwise prearranged.
